

Maintenance of your Crescent Garden Planters



Our Crescent Garden branded planters are made to last, season after season. All our finishes are not applied finishes in the final stages of production, making them extremely durable. However, when used outdoors our products are exposed to the elements and can get soiled. Here are a few tips on how to clean these up easily:

Everyday Solution:

A vinegar and water solution (25/75) works very well to remove especially hard water stains. The key is to leave it on for at least 10 minutes to really penetrate and remove. Ideally if you have a pressure cleaner these can come off easily once vinegar has penetrated the stains. Otherwise using a good sponge and a lot of water you should be able to remove most of it. Do not use abrasive sponges as these can scratch the material.

The Professional Cleanup:

For professionals that are used to working with stronger chemicals below is a great concoction that will speed up your cleaning:

- Mix water with acetic acid (3-5%), (commercial vinegar)
- Add in equal parts a non-chlorine bleach liquid soap to the above mixture.
(An oxygen bleach is ideal.)

Same as the everyday solution we recommend leaving the mixture on the planter for a few minutes before cleaning.
